



2024 “Amaneceres” Reserva Sémillon



Wine

The vineyard is located at 950 meters above sea level on the north bank of the Mendoza River, in Drummond, Luján de Cuyo. Very old 90 years old vines. The wine was aged in French oak barrels from Burgundy and to enhance texture and complexity, it is bottled unfiltered, thus its cloudy appearance.

Tasting Notes

Notes of white flowers, white stone fruits, lychee, lemon, pear, vanilla, honey, grass and a hint of smoke. Elegant, silky texture, balanced acidity and a long finish.
